The General Assembly, designed to be a three-day immersive experience, promises an engaging and thought-provoking and solution oriented programme. The event will cover key topics strictly related to ALDA's Hubs among which citizens engagement, equality, Human migration, gender Rights, engagement, digitatlisation and territorial approach to local development.

The ALDA Festival and General Assembly 2024 will represent the meeting point and discussion of local activities carried out on a global scale. 


