SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

The “Empowering European Citizens” Seminar aimed to empower young European citizens by fostering their knowledge, understanding, and engagement with the European Union. The Seminar took place in Nocera Umbra, Italy, and consisted of a totally free week of study–vacation, which combined lectures and group discussion with recreational activities. In particular, each morning the participants first attended a lecture on various topics concerning the European Union, and then were divided into four discussion groups to debate the topic of the lecture. Finally, the groups met in plenary, where each presented their work to the others and the experts.

The events achieved several key objectives: a) they fortified Decidim as a tool for participatory oversight and implementation of youth-driven policy proposals on mental health; b) they deepened the integration of Legislative Theatre with Decidim, transforming the platform into a more visual and user-responsive space; and c) they successfully implemented these practices in Spain.

In particular, the project involved two parallel workshops in Naples and Turin, where the main focus was on empowering the participants through training and capacity-building, providing them with the tools to explore and map their cities while developing an intercultural understanding of local heritage and the significance of places. Two final events were organised to present the project's results, bringing together the participants and their work in both cities. Additionally, a community of practice meeting took place between the groups, encouraging cross-city dialogue and collaboration.

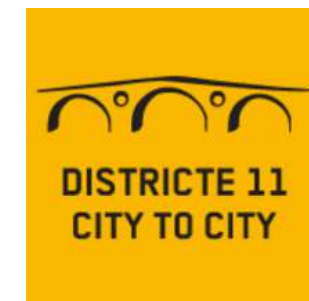

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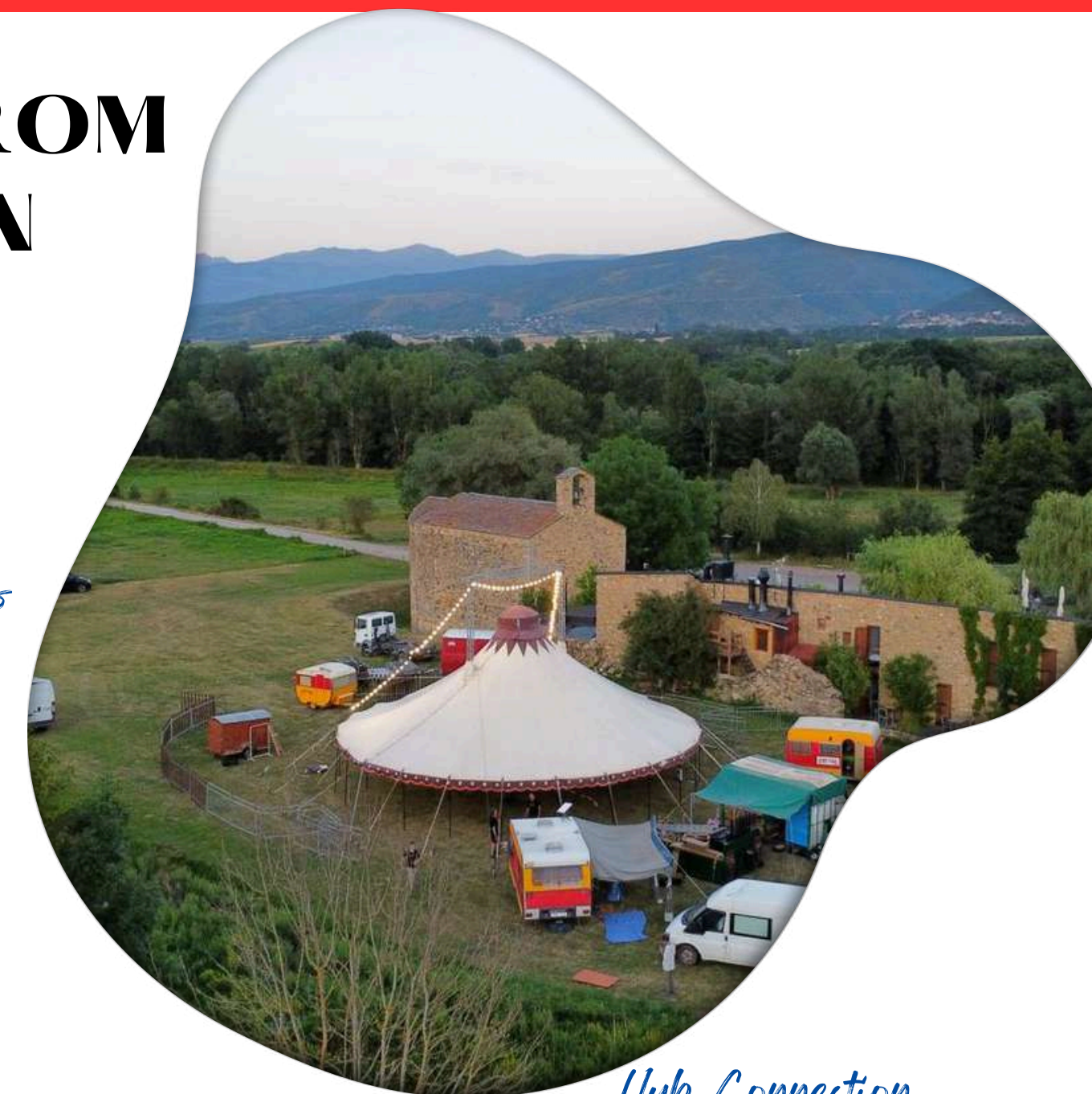
